| Rules: | Rule 1400 : Sanctioned Show Rules as found on the ABGA website Original registration certification is required for all animals. Tattoo's must be legible and match registration papers. All goats must have a current Health paper as required by the state of Kansas. It is the owner's responsibility to conform to all interstate transport laws, in compliance with the USDA animal movement restrictions. Registration certificates and current health papers for animals from out of state must be presented to the KMGGA Secretary when checking in. Show personal, veterinarian, or state/federal personnel may inspect animals and will bar from the grounds any animal that is obviously sick, diseased or parasite infected. Animals not being shown are prohibited, unless a kid is nursing; then the kid and doe must have health papers if traveling from out of state. Registration certificates are required for all animals over 3 months of age. No dogs allowed in the barn. |
